BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT

Isolate, practice social distancing and masking prior to surgery

Call Ambulatory Care Center to make an appointment for COVID-19 testing.

- Collection must be done 3-4 days before surgery
- o "Drive through" process at center
- A long swab will be inserted in your nose to the back of your nasal passage. Your eyes will likely water and it may be uncomfortable for a moment or two.
- Results will be available in 42 72 hours. The center will call you.

See your primary care physician or specialists as directed by your surgeon. Also, get lab work as ordered.

Ambulatory Care Center will call you 5 – 7 days before your procedure to perform a health screening.

 Results will be available in 42 – 72 hours. The center will call you.

Arrive for surgery with insurance and ID. We will do a final screening and temperature check. You will be asked to provide a cell phone number for your escort. No one is allowed in Ambulatory Care Center except for the patient
